Brief:

SA was commissioned to work on the restoration of Redland Farm house and outbuildings. The client was intending to convert the outbuildings in to living accommodation to raise revenue for supporting the remainder of the farm.



Solution:

Using the latest architectural CAD software, the practice created a number of schemes that were formally presented to the client. All solutions considered sympathetic use of materials and practices to comply with listed building consent. Scale models were created of the final scheme to provide the client with an insight to the finished result. Converting the main barn to a studio increased the rental income.
